

Alternate Assessment for Students with Disabilities

Additional Frequently Asked Questions

1. Now that Entry Sheets are not to be included in the Collection of Evidence Notebooks, can the dividers be labeled?

IF THEY WISH, TEACHERS MAY IDENTIFY EACH DIVIDER OR DIVIDER TAB AS ENTRY 1, ENTRY 2, ETC. The dividers that will be provided with the binder materials will be blank.

2. For applications that use “/” instead of a conjunction, does it mean “and”, “or” or “either”?

IN APPLICATIONS THAT USE THE “/” SYMBOL, SUCH AS IN APPLICATION 124, “MATCH/USE ABBREVIATIONS TO COMMON WORDS.” THE “/” SIGN MEANS “AND/OR”. So, application 124 could be read, “Match and/or use abbreviations to common words.”
